NAPLAN

The 2016 National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) will be completed by students in Years 3 and 5. NAPLAN has the support of all State and Territory Education Ministers and will assess the literacy and numeracy skills of students across Australian schools. The results of the tests will provide important information to schools about what each student can do, and will be used to support teaching and learning programs. Parents will receive a report indicating their child's level of achievement. Each student's level of achievement will be reported against the national minimum standard.

The NAPLAN tests will be conducted from 10 – 12 May 2016.

Keep Kids Safe #parentscheckthecheck!

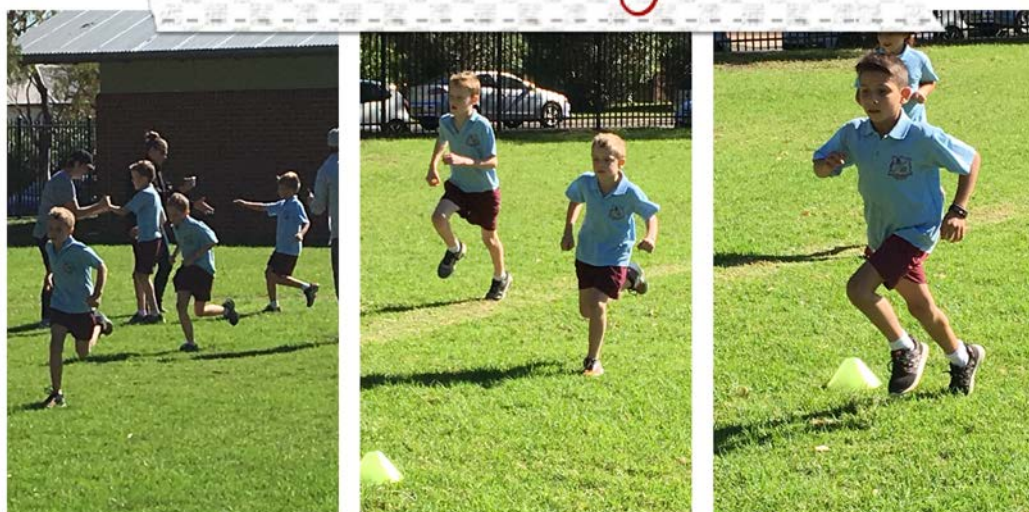

A Working With Children Check clearance means a person is permitted to work with children in NSW. As their 'employer', a parent has a legal responsibility to check their tutor's name, date of birth and WWCC number to ensure they have been cleared. If you suspect that an adult is providing services to children without a WWCC you can also make a confidential report to the Office of the Children's Guardian. 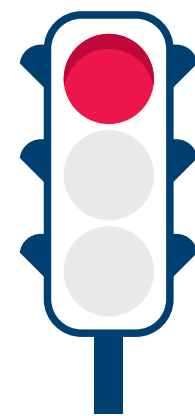
Canteen News

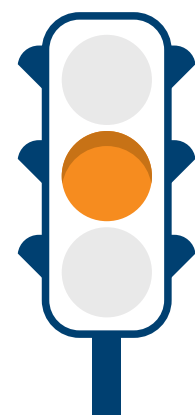

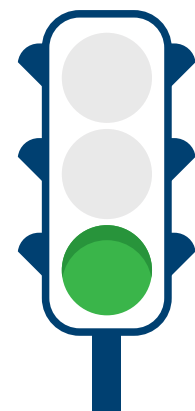
