Staff Professional Learning

This week, four staff will be attending; Tier 1, Universal Training Prevention, Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) a two day course at Menai Primary School. As indicated in the 2015-2017 School Plan, Strategic Direction Three, PBL training will support the school and community to develop a framework that has consistent language, expectations and a whole school approach to supporting learning and behaviour.

Walk Safely to School Day

Friday 20 May is "Walk Safety to School Day". This day promotes walking as part of a healthy, active way to get around. You can teach your child the healthy habit of walking more by:

Walking with them the whole way to school if practical

- If they get the bus or train, walk past your usual stop and get on at the next stop
- If you have to drive, park the car a few blocks away from the school and walk the rest of the way



Where possible, students are encouraged to walk to school on Friday 20 May. Children must always hold an adults hand when crossing the road until they are 10 years old.

Camp Quality Puppets

On Tuesday 24 May the Camp Quality Puppets will visit SNPS. The puppets help students and teachers learn how to create a supportive school community for children affected by cancer, whether they are living with cancer themselves or have a family member living with cancer. The program consists of a live, educational puppet show focusing on cancer education, optimism and friendship. 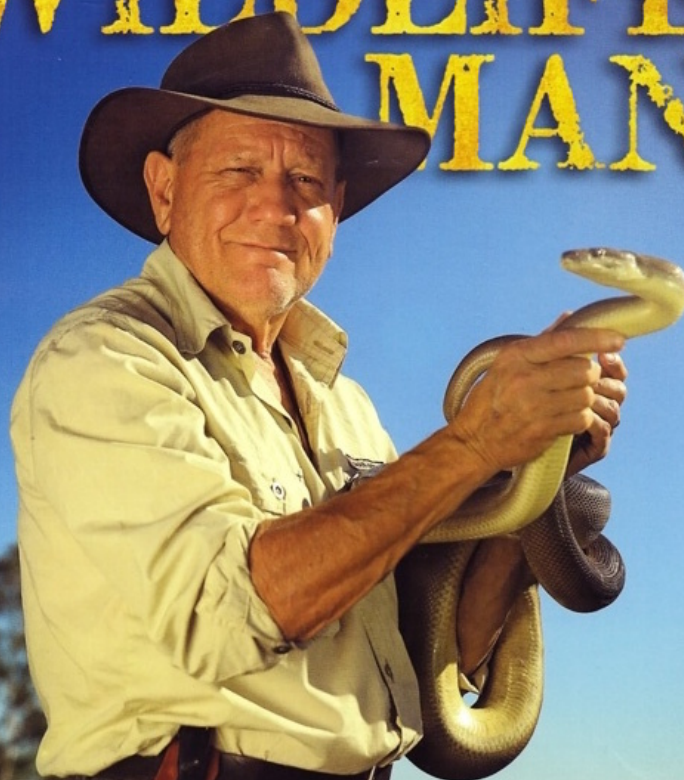
