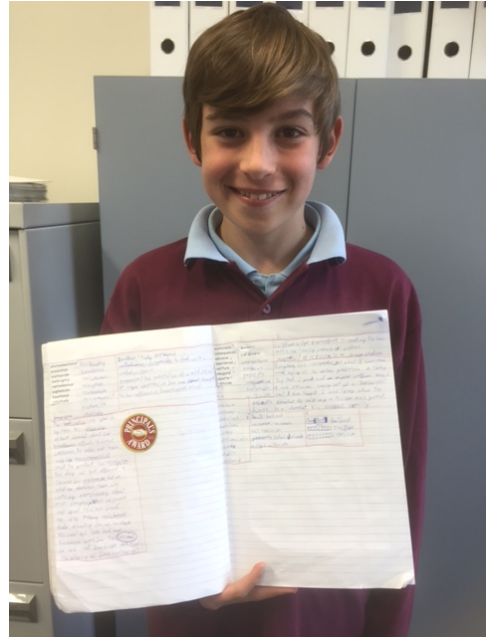
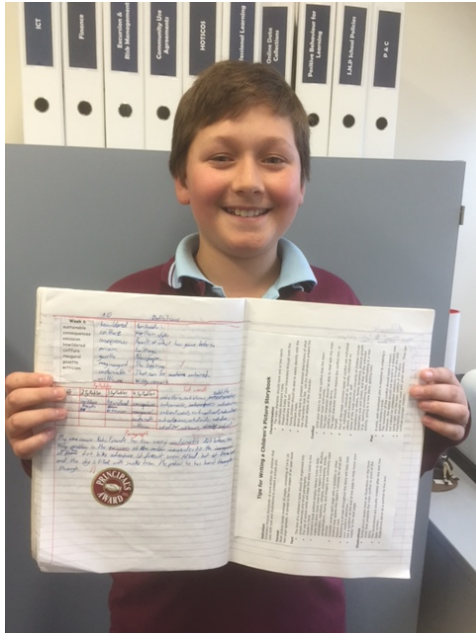

YEAR SIX CPR COURSE

On Wednesday, the Year Six students learnt CPR with Colleen from Surf Life Saving Australia. During this time, we learnt what to do if someone collapses and is unconscious. We also learnt how to use a defibrillator in an emergency and where we would find a defibrillator (like supermarkets, hospitals, etc.). We practiced CPR on mannequins and were given a card that reminds us what to do in an emergency.

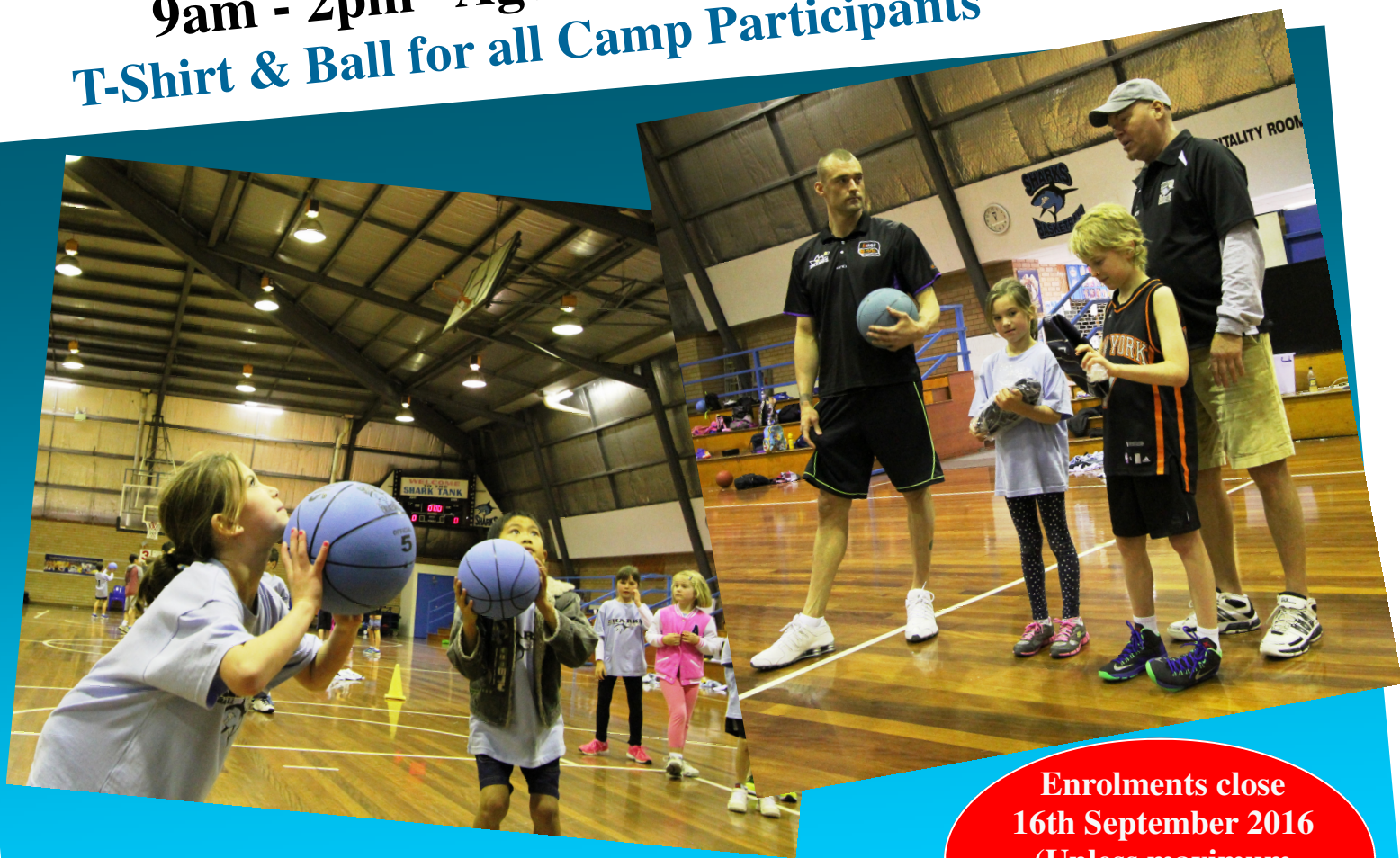

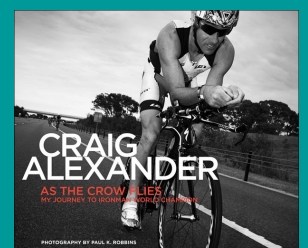
