Non School Uniform Items

Sutherland North is a proud uniform wearing school. Wearing full school uniform brings our students together and ensures they take pride in their school. It has come to my attention students are frequently wearing items that are not part of SNPS required school uniform and therefore are not to be worn at school. In particular; nail polish is not to be worn, jewellery is to be kept to a minimum e.g. sleepers or studs for pierced ears, signet rings & a watch. Hair ties, ribbons/bows or scrunchies are to be maroon, navy blue or white only and be kept to a discreet size. Although lovely, giant bows and sparkly accessories are not part of the school uniform. Joggers are to be worn on sport days only. All other shoes should be black lace ups or Velcro tabs.

I appreciate your support with ensuring the children continue to look well-presented in their uniforms.

Asthma Plans

To ensure the school is in the best possible position to support your child in the event of a medical situation, **Asthma Plans**, **Anaphylaxis** and/or any other student **Healthcare Plans** must be updated and provided to the school **every 12 months**. The school has a Duty of Care to all of our students. Our legal obligation at any given time requires staff to respond according to the documented information on student medical plans held on our records. Whether or not your child's medication regime has changed it is a requirement of the Department of Education to provide the school with an updated plan every 12 months. Please assist the school to support your child by providing updated Health Care Plans when required.

Year 2 Junior Choir Performance at Thomas Holt Nursing Home

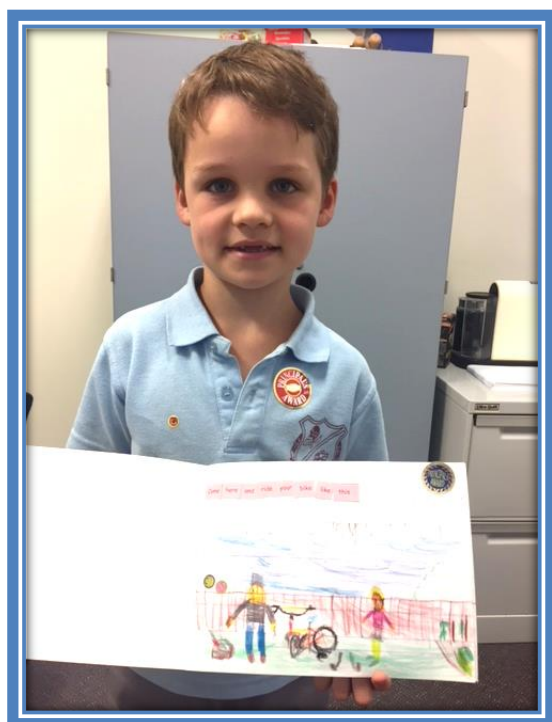



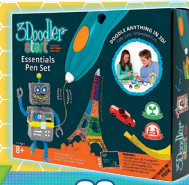
