2018 Planning and Organisation

We are currently in the process of organising staffing and student classes for 2018. Today our numbers indicate we will remain with 11 classes in 2018. If your child/ren will not be returning to our school in 2018 (apart from year 6) please put this in writing to me as soon as possible.

If your child will not be present for the first two weeks of the 2018 school year but will be returning to SNPS this must also be communicated in writing to the Principal as soon as possible.

Student Allocation Process

The school staffing structure and formation of classes at SNPS is governed by the Department of Education staffing formula. A school structure that best meets the needs of all students and teachers is a collaborative process designed by staff and ratified by the Principal. The Principal has the delegated authority to determine the final makeup of classes.

The classes are formed in the best interests of ALL the students. In this process the following criteria, not in order of importance is taken into consideration.

Identification of Student Needs

This is achieved through:

- Professional conversations and consultation with staff who are familiar with students
- Has the student been taught by the teacher in previous years
- Academic and welfare data
- Learning adjustment requirements
- Student friendships, personalities
- Students educational history
- Behaviour support
- Gender balance
- Significant information that may be provided by parents of educational reasoning (history, social and emotional factors).

Allocation of Teachers

This is determined after a consultative process that takes into consideration:

- Teacher preferences
- Past experience
- Skill and expertise
- Professional learning goals
- Effective balanced stage teams
- New teachers to the school and/or Graduate Teachers

Selective High School 2019

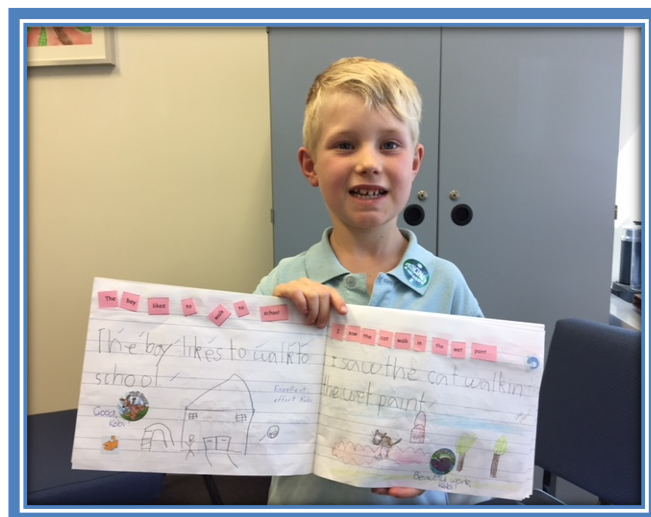
