School Gates

The following changes to morning and after school gate entry was implemented at the beginning of last week. The following changes will remain in place for student safety.

- **AUBURN Street:** the gate directly beside the **school hall** is used for **Cubby House - Before and After School Care** access. **This gate is closed but not locked.** All parents and carers are asked to use the vertical sliding bolt to open and close the gate.
- **AUBURN Street:** The **Office** (main entry gate) remains the same.
- **MOIRA Street:** Gate will be unlocked at **8.20am** and locked at **3.20pm** each day.

Please note: Students should **not** be on school grounds prior to 8.30am. Teacher supervision starts at 8.30am.

Cubby House - before and after school care is available onsite if you require care before 8.30am and/or at the end of the school day after 3pm.
