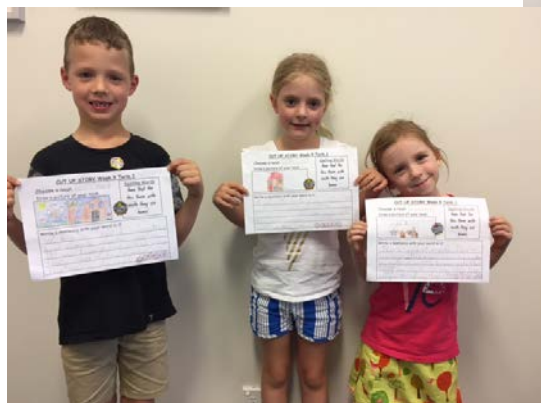

Premier's Reading Challenge 2017

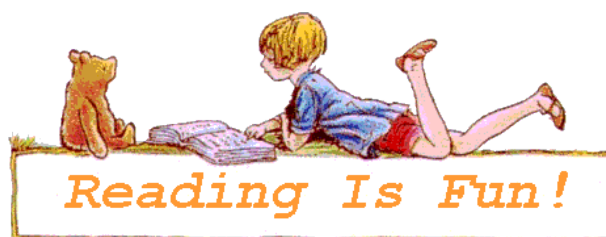
Congratulations to those children who have registered for the Premier's Reading Challenge 2017. We already have 4 children who have completed it.
