### Kindergarten Enrolments 2018

We are now accepting enrolment applications for 2018. Any school families with pre-schoolers turning 5 years by 31 July 2018 and are ready for school are eligible to enrol. If you have family, friends or neighbours interested in enrolling at Sutherland North, please encourage them to enrol soon, so that plans for transition to Kindergarten can be developed. We will be holding a *Starting School* information session for parents at **7.30pm on Wednesday 9 August 2017**. There will also be a Kindergarten 2018 School Tour at **9.30am on Wednesday 16 August** for interested parents/carers. Our Kindergarten Transition activities for the children will be held in Term 4.

### NAPLAN

As mentioned last week the 2017 National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) will be completed by students in Years 3 and 5. NAPLAN has the support of all State and Territory Education Ministers and will assess the literacy and numeracy skills of students across Australian schools. The results of the tests will provide important information to schools about what each student can do, and will be used to support teaching and learning programs. Parents will receive a report indicating their child's level of achievement. Each student's level of achievement will be reported against the national minimum standard.

The NAPLAN tests will be conducted from 9 -11 May 2017.
