Paper bags or lunch order bags purchased at the uniform shop can still be used.

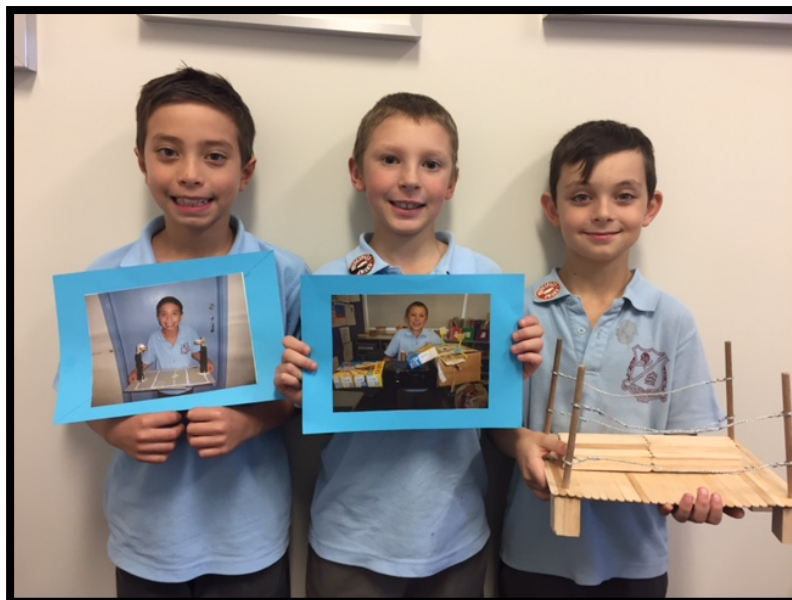

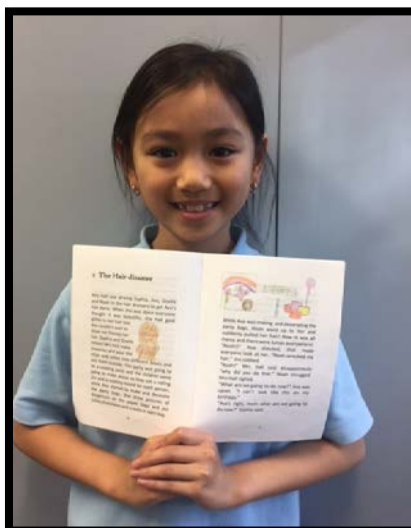

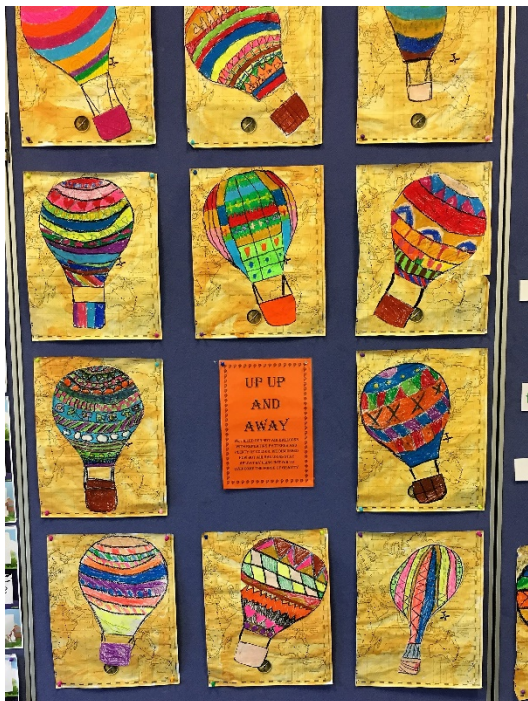
