Presentation Day Awards

Our school's annual presentation day will be held on Monday 11 December. This is an occasion where we recognise student achievement and celebrate success. Each classroom teacher selects students to receive awards. There are other awards that are also presented on this day. These elite awards are given to students for outstanding achievement in particular areas. The worthy recipients are nominated and voted on by staff. These awards include:

DUX

The Dux of the school is awarded to a Year 6 student. It is the most prestigious of all the awards. The criteria used to select the recipient includes:

- * Progressive assessment results in English and Mathematics for the current year.
- * NAPLAN results from Year 3 and Year 5.
- * Student's end of year results in Year 5.
- * If applicable, university NSW exam results in Year 6 and Year 5.
- * Decision made collaboratively by Year 6 teachers; reviewing achievement, application and consistency.

The Thistlethwaite Creative & Performing Arts Award

This award is presented to a child who shows skill & dedication in an area of Creative Arts. The award was donated by the Thistlethwaite family who supported the Creative & Performing Arts at Sutherland North for many years. The recipient of this award excels in at least two of the four areas of the Creative Arts. These are drama, music, visual arts and dance.

The Allan Symes School Spirit Award

This award is donated by the P&C and presented to a Year 6 student who has worked consistently well, displays outstanding school spirit and exemplary behaviour. Allan Symes was a teacher at Sutherland North for 28 years and is a much-loved member of the community.

The Valentine Shield

The Valentine Shield is awarded to an outstanding sportsperson. It was donated to the school by the Valentine family, whose three daughters were exceptional athletes. Throughout the year, each student is awarded points for their placings in Swimming Carnivals, Cross Country Carnivals and Athletics Carnivals, with extra points given for placing in Carnival Finals. Points are also awarded for participation in PSSA teams and Zone, Regional and State sporting endeavours (conducted through the school). Abiding by the relevant Codes of Conduct and respecting coaches, teammates and other schools is also considered.

The Geddes Family Caring Award

This award is presented to a child in Year 2 who shows a caring and thoughtful attitude towards others. This award is in remembrance of Mrs Meg Geddes, a kind, helpful parent, who was tragically killed on Presentation Night 1988.

The Bryant Shield

Presented to the Senior Champion Boy and Girl Swimmer. This is the oldest trophy in our collection, which was inaugurated in 1970. Mrs Grace Bryant taught Life Saving Skills as part of our swimming program for many years.

The Mills, Vella, Webber Shield

The shield is presented to the Senior Champion Boy and Girl Athlete. The Mills, Vella and Webber families are all from our first classes at Sutherland North in 1948 and 1949.
