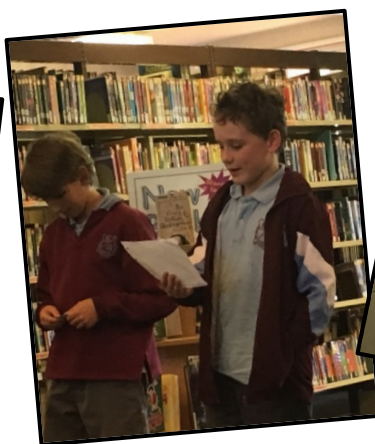
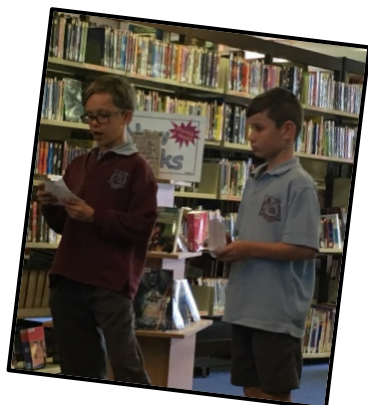
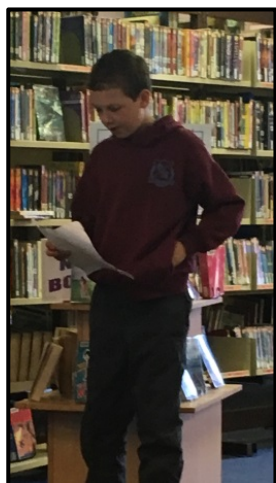
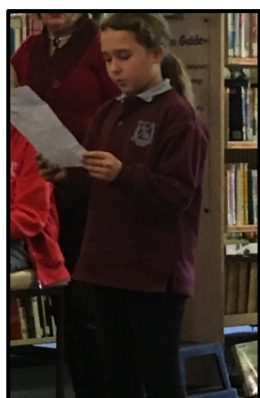
Also, congratulations to Blake in 5/6S who has been selected in the Sydney East PSSA Softball team and will compete in the State Championships in October. Well done Blake!
