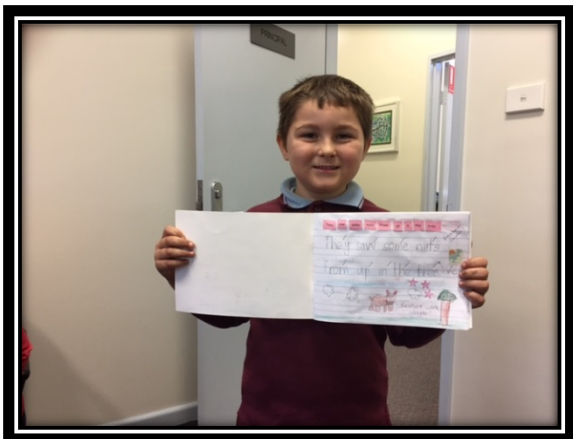
### Lightsup Workshop

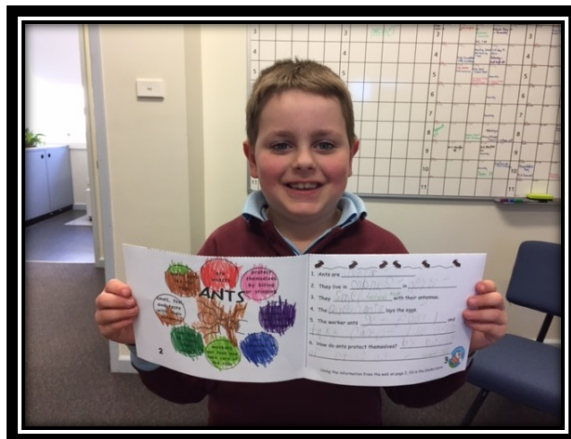
### Athletics Carnival
