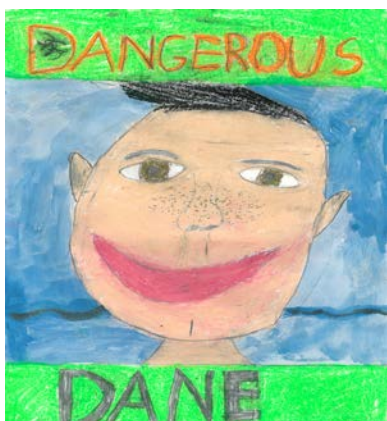
This year, the talented students in 2/3E have created wonderful artworks with their RFF art teacher Mrs Moseley. Here is sample of some of their work.



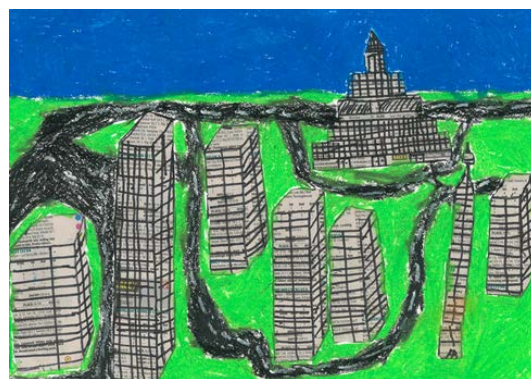
