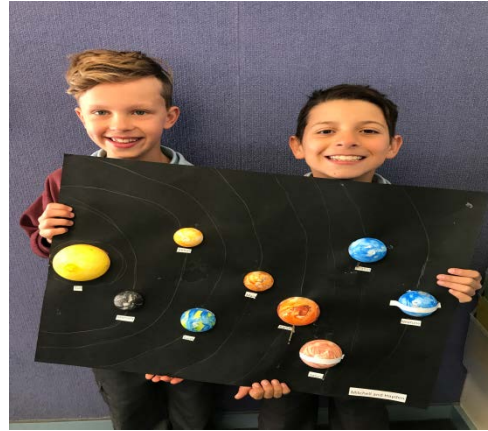
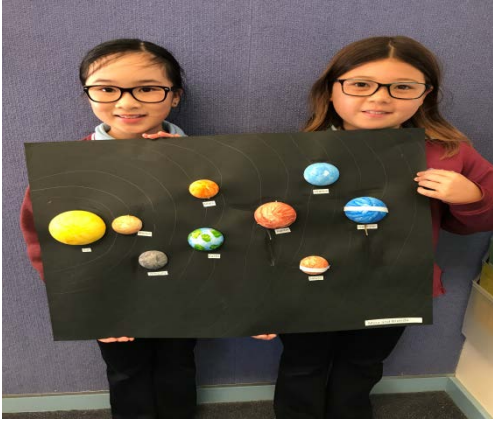

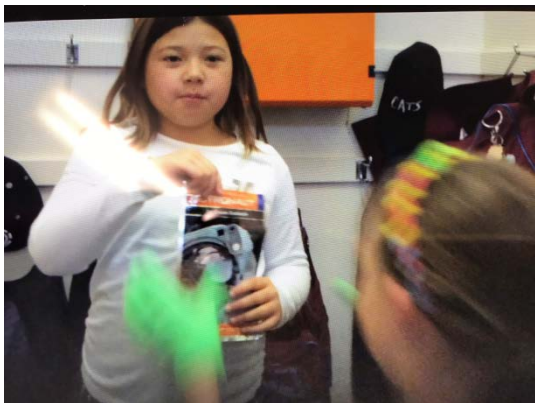

ANSTO Top Coder Competition

This talented Year 5 team will compete in the ANSTO Top Coder Grand Final which will be held at ANSTO Discovery Centre on 24 October. Abigail H and Jayden G also represented Sutherland North Public School in this competition and produced a quality coding project. The ANSTO Top Coder Team were coached by Mr Stone.

Over 40 schools have competed in the 2017 ANSTO Top Coder Competition and teachers from Sutherland North Public School have worked with ANSTO to promote this initiative. Mr Entwistle created the concept and directs the overall competition, Ms Coates coordinated Round 3 (Oatley PS) and 5 (Ramsgate PS), and Mrs Kingsnorth coordinated Round 3 (Baulkham Hill North PS). Participation in the ANSTO Top Coder Competition has tripled since staff at Sutherland North Public School became involved this year with over 160 students across the Sydney region attending the event. 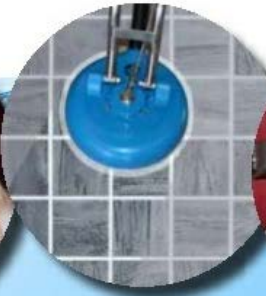
