Kindergarten Enrolments 2019

We are now accepting enrolment applications for 2019. Any school families with pre-schoolers turning 5 years by 31 July 2019 and are ready for school are eligible to enrol. If you have family, friends or neighbours interested in enrolling at Sutherland North, please encourage them to enrol soon, so that plans for transition to Kindergarten can be developed. We will be holding a **Starting School** information session for parents on **Wednesday 8 August 2018** from **6 - 7pm**. There will also be a Kindergarten 2019 School Tour **10-11am on Wednesday 1 August** for interested parents/carers. Our Kindergarten Transition activities for the children will be held in Term 4.

Student Arrival

Teachers are rostered on to supervise students from 8.30am until classes commence. The teacher on playground duty wears a fluoro vest so that they can be easily identified by all students. On arrival at school children are to put their bags away in their classroom and move straight to the supervised playground. Students are not to hang around their classroom waiting for friends. The only exception to this is if it is Wet Weather.

All classes line up under the cola area each morning when the music is heard at 8.55am. The music is a signal to parents to let them know it is time to leave the playground so that the children can hear their teachers' instructions and commence classes quickly.

Early Departure

If parents need to collect children during school hours where possible, please make these collection times outside of break times; recess - 11am-11.30am or lunch 1.15pm-2.00pm. This will ensure you are not kept waiting longer than necessary while staff try to locate children while in the playgrounds. Providing the teacher with a brief note on the day can also help the school to have your child ready and waiting in the office area.

Semester 1 Student Reports

The teachers are currently assessing the children and preparing Semester 1 reports. Student reports will be sent home on Wednesday 4 July. Parents who would like to discuss their child's report are asked to contact the class teacher directly. Involvement by parents and carers in your child's education and school is an important factor in helping children achieve the best possible learning outcomes and feel secure and happy in the school environment.






