Illness

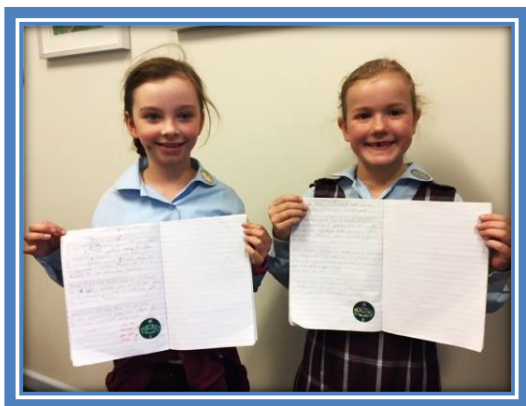

We would like to thank Rhonda Wilson (Maclaryn and Lila Hackett's grandmother) and Julie Gallan (National Park Environment Education Centre) who have helped set up the garden and educate the students.
Thank you also to the Kempton family who donated a Bunnings voucher. This was greatly appreciated and was used to purchase netting and stakes.

Thank you to the thoughtful parents who donated: gardening gloves, seedlings, seeds, mulch and fertiliser. These will be put to good use.

The school now has a Green Team made up of student volunteers from across the school. The Green Team have been working hard to get the garden growing again and meet regularly to maintain the garden and learn about composting and worm farming. The garden will be utilised for science units involving all stages across the school.

How can you help?

Glad you asked! We would love to hear from any parent volunteers who can assist with watering the garden once a week. This would require 10 minutes of your time in the afternoon or morning. Please leave your name at the office if you are interested.

We could also use the following items:

- Medium and large sized terracotta or ceramic pots
- Fork for turning the compost (kid size)
- Shovel with a flat edge (kid size)
- Bags of soil and manure
- Small garden shed (perhaps you have one that is no longer used)
- Packets of seeds (flowers and vegies)



We couldn't have done this without the support of our local community and look forward to working with parent volunteers to ensure we can keep our garden growing.

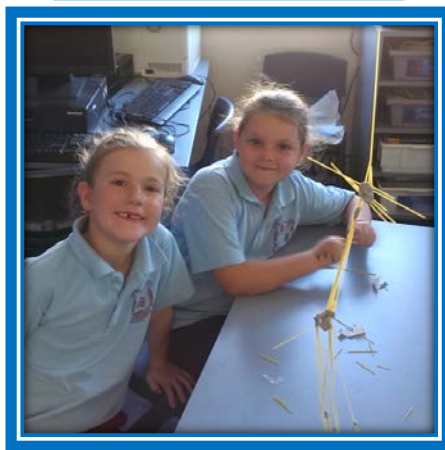
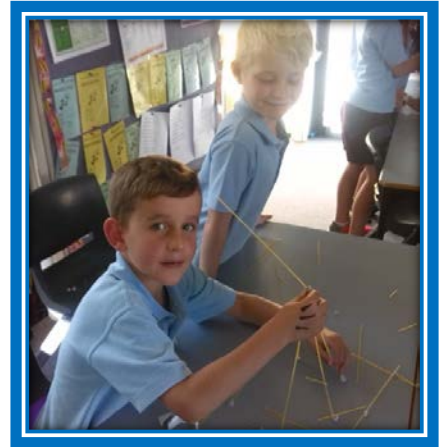
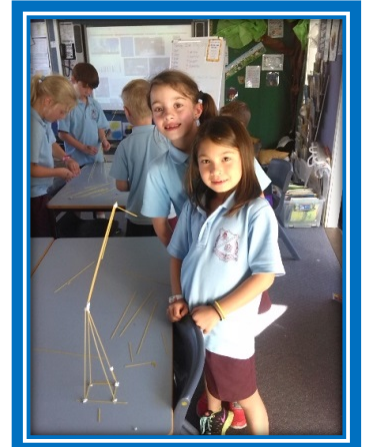

Our school is once again participating in the Sutherland Shire Schools Music Festival (SSSMF) at the Sutherland Entertainment Centre (SEC) in August. Tickets for this event will only be available online. This year the sale date for concerts will be staggered.

Tickets for **Concerts 6 - 10** go on sale on **Friday 8 June 2018**. On this day, tickets will be available to anyone wishing to purchase on a first-in, first served basis. As tickets traditionally sell out for some of the concerts, we recommend you order yours as early as possible. In the unlikely event that there are unsold tickets for a particular concert, these will be available at the box office on afternoon/night of the concert.

Tickets this year are \$19.50. Due to health and safety regulations, **the Sutherland Entertainment Centre will not allow children to sit on parents' laps**. Each person attending the concert will require a ticket.

There will be fifteen concerts available to purchase tickets to so it is **very important** that you select the correct concert/s.

When ordering your tickets, you will have the opportunity to pre-purchase a printed program for \$5.00. This program contains all of the concerts as well as artwork by students from the Shire and makes a wonderful souvenir. Your pre purchased program/s will be delivered to the school prior to the event.
