Local Roads

With an increase in numbers our local roads are becoming very busy at morning drop off and the afternoon pick up. We always encourage all parents to obey local road rules for the safety of students and families. It is important to remember that local police and council officers do patrol roads outside of our school on a regular basis.

Earn and Return

We are going to be launching the **Earn and Return** initiative this **Thursday 21 February**. It is a great way to get our students involved in recycling, whilst raising money for our school at the same time. Most 150ml to 3 litre drink containers are eligible for a 10 cent refund.

ELIGIBLE DRINK CONTAINERS

Under Return and Earn, most empty 150ML to 3 Litre drink containers are eligible for a 10 cent refund. These include:

- Plastic
- Aluminium
- Steel
- Liquid paperboard (cartons)

CONTAINERS MUST BE EMPTY, UNCRUSHED, UNBROKEN AND HAVE THE ORIGINAL LABEL ATTACHED

The recycle bins with the **BLUE LIDS** will be located at the entry gate between Mrs Minogues and Miss Morgans classroom, Auburn Street.

CONTAINERS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A RETURN

Containers that are not included in the Scheme and, therefore, do not qualify for a refund are:

- plain milk or milk substitute containers
- flavoured milk containers of 1 litre or more
- pure fruit or vegetable juice containers of 1 litre or more
- glass containers for wine or spirits
- casks (plastic bladders in boxes) for wine and casks or water of 1 litre or more
- sachets for wine of 250 millilitres or more
- containers for cordials, or concentrated fruit and vegetable juices
- registered health tonics

Mrs Te Puke is coordinating the program with the help of our eco warriors. Students who are placing recyclables into the bins will receive individual coloured tokens for their class. The class tokens will be counted twice a term. The class with the most tokens will be given 15 minutes extra play after lunch. The tokens are then started again.

The funds raised will be spent on playground equipment this year.

Early Departure

If parents need to collect children during school hours where possible, please make these collection times outside of break times; recess - 11am-11.30am or lunch 1.15pm-2.00pm. This will ensure you are not kept waiting longer than necessary. Providing the teacher with a brief note on the day can also help the school to have your child ready and waiting in the office area.



UTS STEM Pilot

Year 5 and 6 students are participating in the 2019 UTS Primary STEM Outreach Pilot Program every Tuesday in Term 1 between recess and lunch. Students in Year 5 and 6 have been working with UTS lecturers and students in STEM projects that involve the use of robots and digital technology. UTS has requested that parents become involved in this project by joining a focus group and completing a Pre and Post survey. The focus group meeting will be held on Tuesday 26th February from 3pm-3.30pm after an Open Classroom from 2.30pm-3.00pm in Mr Entwistle's room.
