Stage 3: UTS Pilot Program



During session three of the UTS Primary Pilot, Stage 3 students worked with university lecturers and students using Micro:bits to test the conductivity of the soil to measure moisture levels. This task was used to support students in conducting their Living World experiment, in which students have experimented with the different factors that have influenced plant growth. With the assistance of UTS lecturers and students, our students assembled and coded the micro:bits to measure conductivity in the soil of their plants. Then using their results, they considered the impact this had on their plants and how this might be used in the real world to assist farmers or other professionals working in agriculture. Further sessions with UTS will involve exploration of robotics, building students understanding of coding and the application of robotics within the real world.

Parents are invited to attend a UTS Primary Pilot lesson on Tuesday 2nd April 2019 from 12.30-1.00pm.

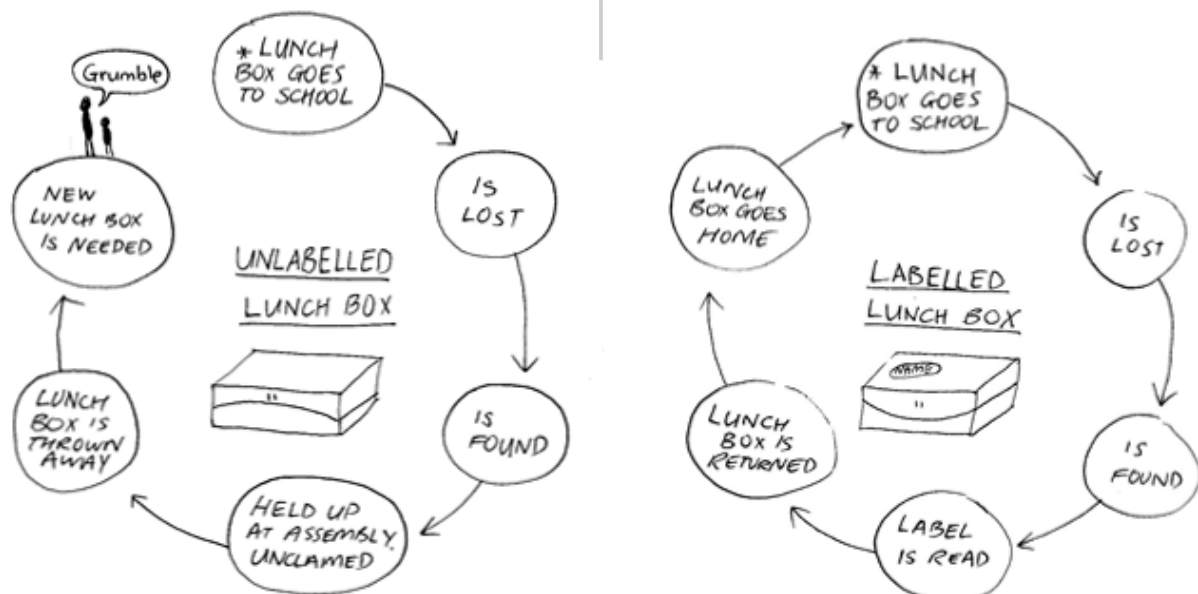
If anyone is available to assist wrapping the prizes we will have a wrapping morning in the hall on Thursday 28th of March.

The winners of the raffle will be announced after the Easter hat parade on Thursday 4th of April.

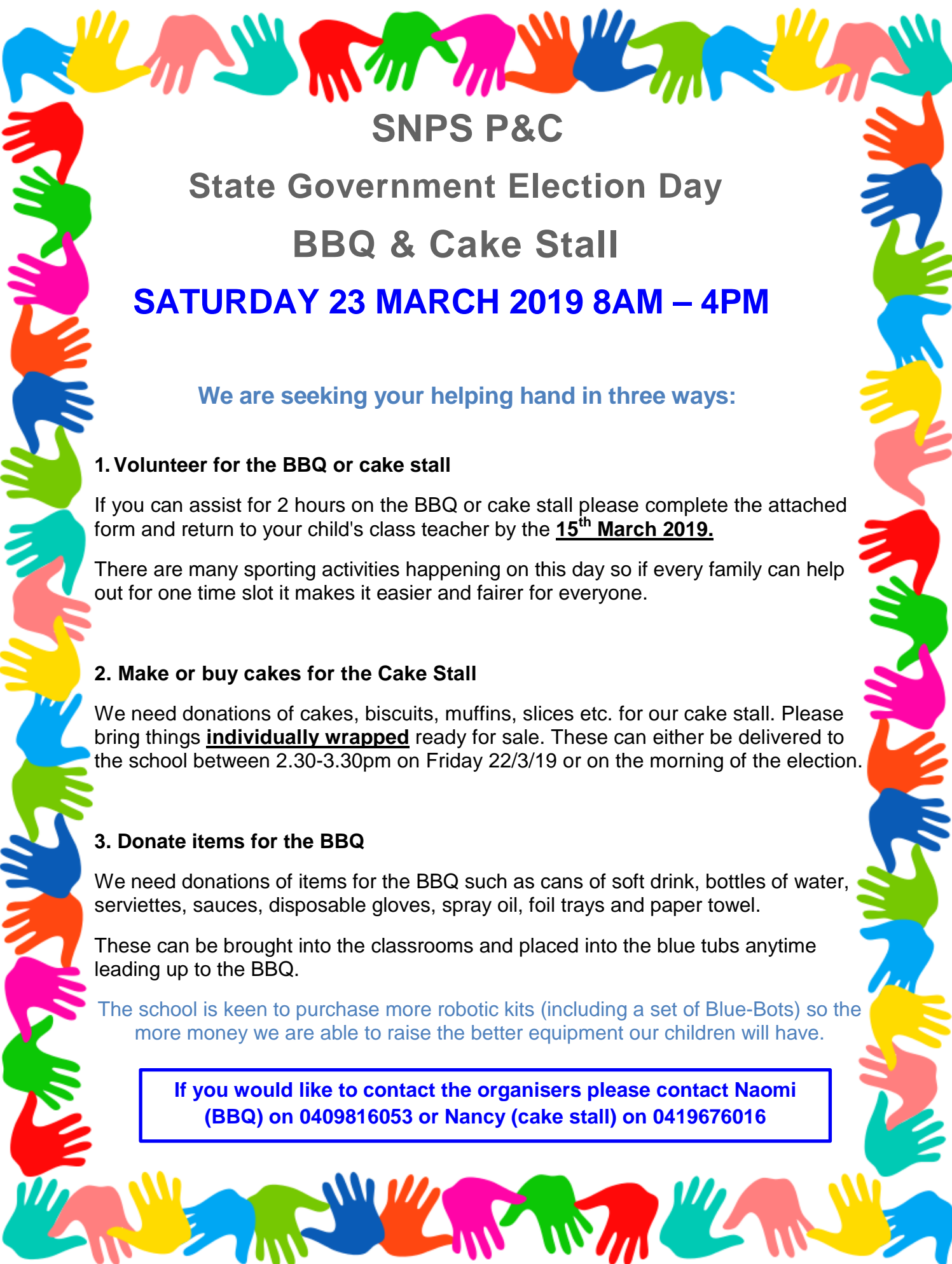
