The next P&C meeting Wednesday 11 September has been cancelled due to the Year 5 students participating in the Dance Sport Gala Competition at Homebush.

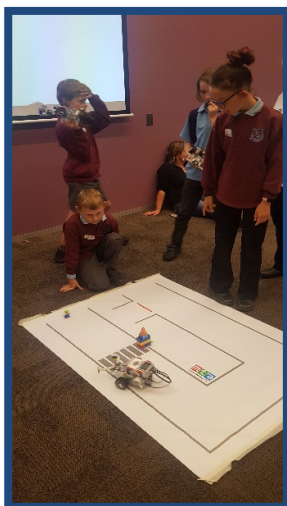

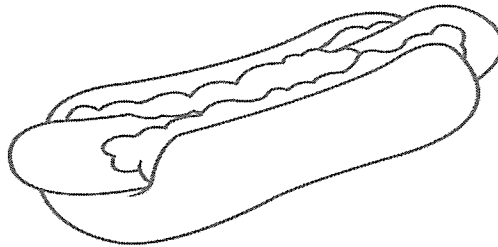
