

Sickness

There is currently a great deal of sickness amongst the students and staff. Winter is upon us and predicted to be a terrible flu season. If your child is sick or has flu like symptoms, please keep them at home until they have fully recovered to prevent the ongoing spread of illness amongst other children and staff.

Casual teaching and SLSO staff are in high demand across the region and our school has been frequently left without replacement staff to cover teacher absences. When staff cannot be replaced our students are provided with workbooks for the day and the class is split across the school K-6. Or as was the case last week one class had a different casual teacher on class every day because of the shortage. The school does everything possible to have casual teachers in place for our students to continue with their normal programs. Splitting students across the school is always a last resort.

Student Attendance Policy

Students are required to be at school before 9.00am. There are a large number of students who are consistently late. Late arrivals are recorded as a partial unjustified absence.

Student attendance is constantly monitored at Sutherland North

Public School. As stated in the NSW Attendance Policy, parents &carers are responsible for ensuring the regular attendance of students at school. Parents & carers **must** provide an explanation for their child's absence to the school within 7 days from the first

day of any period of absence through means such as; telephone call, written note, email or via school stream. The 7 day time frame for explaining absences is a requirement of the Education Act (1990). Failure to explain an absence within this time will be recorded as an unjustified absence. Ongoing late arrivals and regular absences without explanation may result in the school engaging the support of the Home School Liaison Officer (HSLO).

Toilet Refurbishment


The toilet refurbishment of the senior block commenced today after being delayed last week. These works should take approximately 2 weeks. Students are very excited to have this brand new facility.

I will be on leave this week and Monday of next week. Miss Maloy will be the relieving Principal in my absence.


