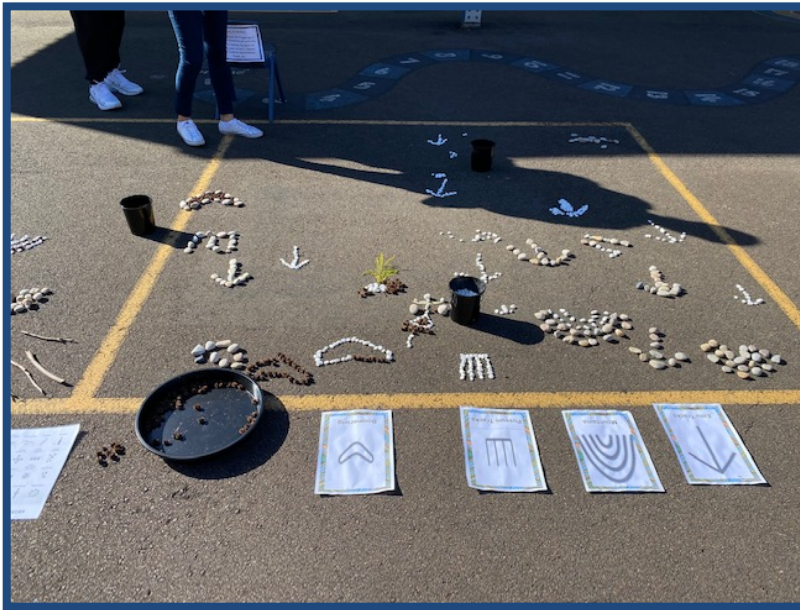
Principal Badge

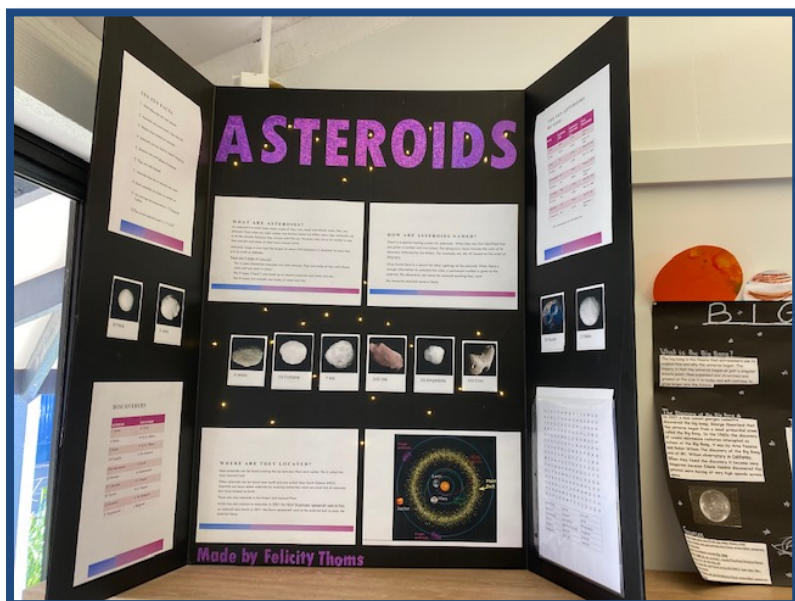
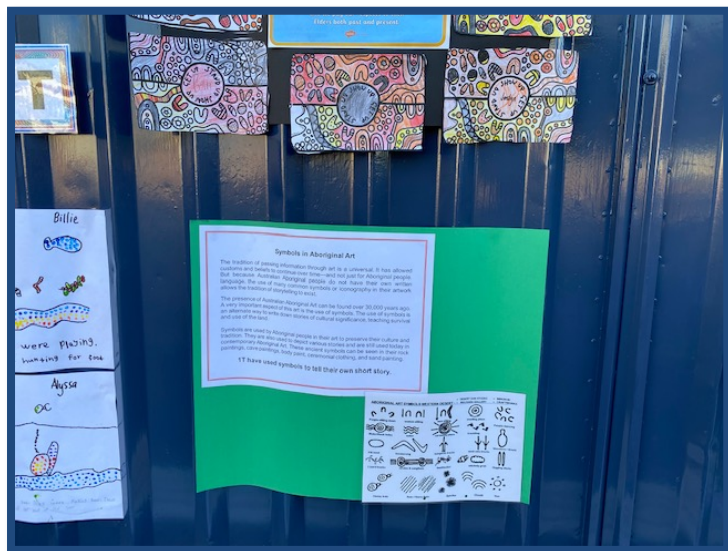
Students receiving their Principal badge will be presented at assembly in week 6. Parents are welcome to attend if your child is receiving a badge.

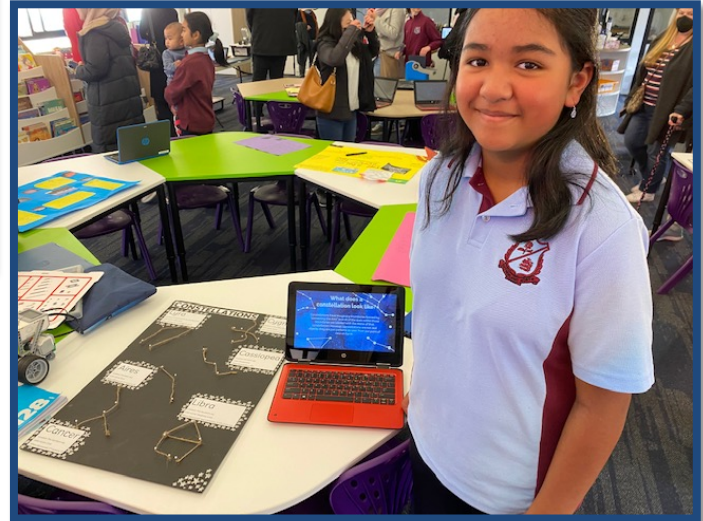
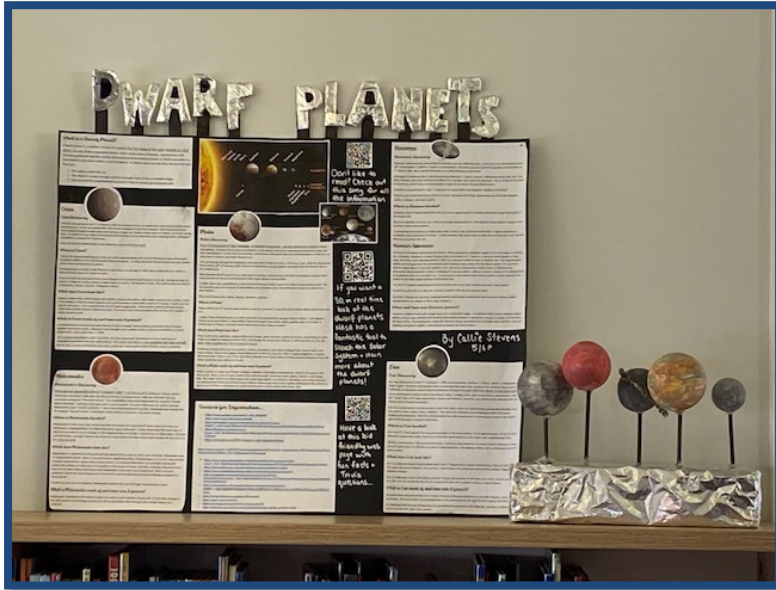
Congratulations
